
THE POOL STOOL PARTS LIST AND INSTRUCTION MANUAL

WARNING:

- THE POOL STOOL IS A SEAT AND SHOULD ONLY BE USED AS A SEAT;
- THE POOL STOOL SHOULD ONLY BE USED IN SHALLOW WATER:
- THE POOL STOOL IS NOT A FLOTATION DEVICE;
- CHILDREN AND THOSE WHO CANNOT SWIM WELL SHOULD NOT USE THE POOL STOOL WITHOUT ADULT SUPERVISION;
- THE POOL STOOL SHOULD BE REMOVED FROM THE POOL WHEN NOT IN USE AS A SEAT;
- THE POOL STOOL SHOULD NOT BE STOOD ON, DOVE OR JUMPED OFF OF OR ON TO, OR OTHERWISE USED IN ANY MANNER OTHER THAN AS A SEAT:
- THE LIGHTING UNIT, IF ANY, SHOULD NOT BE CHARGED, UNLESS THE LIGHTING UNIT IS COMPLETELY DRY:
- THE POOL STOOL SHOULD BE REMOVED, DISASSEMBLED AND CLEANED REGULARLY WITH REGULAR DISH SOAP:
- YOU SHOULD PERMANENTLY DISCONTINUE USE OF THE POOL STOOL IF YOU NOTICE ANY DEFECTS, DISCOLORATION, OR DAMAGE TO THE POOL STOOL;

POOL STOOL INSTRUCTION MANUAL



NOTICE: DO NOT ATTACH CAP TO BOTTLE WEIGHT UNTIL FILLED. CAP IS PERMANENT.

1. ASSEMBLING THE POOL STOOL

- 1.1 Place bottle weight (Part D) on a flat surface and fill with dry sand (funnel and sand not included).
- 1.2 Attach bottle weight cap (Part C) to bottle weight (Part D).
- 1.3 Place base (Part E) on flat surface near pool.
- 1.4 Carefully lift filled bottle weight (Part D) and insert into the base (Part E).
- 1.5 Screw the bottle weight down into the base clockwise, until the bottle weight hits the stop. DO NOT OVERSCREW THE BOTTLE WEIGHT INTO THE BASE.
- 1.6 Optional- Install LED Light unit (Part B), see Installation Instructions Section 2.
- 1.7 Secure the top/seat (Part A) by screwing the top onto the base (Part E) clockwise.
- 1.8 For easy installation into the pool, ensure the top/seat is screwed to the base allowing only the bottom two rungs to be exposed. DO NOT OVERSCREW THE TOP.

2. OPTIONAL LED LIGHT UNIT INSTALLATION

- 2.1 Charge the light unit (Part B) completely, allowing 24 hours prior to installation.
- 2.2 On the underside of the light unit, insert the rubber plug to protect the charging mechanism.
- 2.3 Align the light unit (Part B) openings over the bottle weight (Part D) pegs and turn clockwise to secure.
- 2.4 Power on the light unit using the wireless remote, to test.

3. SINKING THE POOL STOOL

- 3.1 Place the completely assembled Pool Stool near the edge of the pool.
- 3.2 You must be in the pool to sink the Pool Stool.
- 3.3 Grab the base of the Pool Stool and guide the Pool Stool into the pool.
- 3.4 Be careful when placing the Pool Stool into the water as the buoyancy can cause it to push up until all air is released.
- 3.5 Completely submerge the Pool Stool under the water until all air has been displaced. It will take approximately three minutes for this process.

Sit on the Pool Stool and enjoy.

4. RECHARGING THE LED LIGHT UNIT

- 4.1 The Pool Stool does not need to be removed in order to remove the light Unit.
- 4.2 Unscrew the top/seat (Part A) in a counterclockwise motion and place the top outside of the pool.
- 4.3 Remove the light unit (Part B) by rotating it in a slight counterclockwise motion.
- 4.4 Ensure the light unit is completely dry prior to recharging.
- 4.5 On the underside of the unit, remove the rubber plug and insert the charging adapter.
- 4.5 Plug the charger into the outlet and allow the unit to charge completely.
- 4.6 Refer to Instructions Section 2 for reassembly and placement.

5. REMOVING AND STORING THE POOL STOOL

- 5.1 Unscrew the top/seat (Part A) in a counter clockwise motion and place outside the pool.
- 5.2 Remove the light unit (Part B) by rotating it in a slight counterclockwise motion.
- 5.3 Carefully lift the base (Part E) out of the pool, with the bottle weight still in place.
- 5.4 Remove the bottle weight (Part D) from the base (Part E) by rotating in a counter clockwise motion.
- 5.5 Dry all components completely.
- 5.6 Reassemble the Pool Stool, see assembly instructions, and store in a dry place.
